Bank Safety

The City of London Corporation is investigating an experimental scheme to restrict vehicles crossing Bank Junction between 7:00am and 7:00pm Monday to Friday in order to improve safety. This is the time period that 75% of the collisions take place at Bank and it is thought the scheme will save over 50% of the casualties that occur.

The proposal is to restrict traffic to pedal cycle and buses only through the junction. Further investigations are still taking place as to whether taxis will be included in the restriction. Technical work is on-going to make sure the scheme is viable, but early results are positive. It is planned to seek a decision as to whether this scheme will proceed in December. If approved, the restriction will be delivered in April 2017.

For long-term aspirations, the City continues to investigate four options offering various levels of change at Bank Junction and its approaches. These will be developed in more detail with a view to going out to public consultation in the summer of 2017.
